## ***Building Permits Report***

The City has issued building permits with a total valuation of \$211,098,016 through July. This compares to a total valuation of \$182,362,440 for building permits issued through July of 2020.

The City issued permits for 303 single-family homes through July with a total valuation of \$95,999,000. This compares to 312 single-family home permits through July of 2020 with a total valuation of \$93,400,000.



The City has also issued 115 townhome permits with a total valuation of \$24,807,000 through July, compared to 73 townhome permits with a total valuation of \$13,240,000 during the same period in 2020.

Lakeville has issued the highest number of residential permits year-to-date in the Twin Cities followed by Woodbury, Cottage Grove, Otsego and Dayton.
