Weekly Review

Please note, if you have reviewed our Calls for Services, you'll see the Weekly Review doesn't include a comprehensive list of calls to which LPD responded. Incidents included here are based on severity, impact on public safety or other factors.

- Fraud was reported after the victim attempted to secure a rental car with a suspect, found online, who asked for gift card payment. When the victim went to pick up the car, the legitimate rental car company advised they had no record of a rental. When the third-party suspect(s) were called back, they hung up and/or feigned ignorance.
- Officers responded to a Traffic Accident, at 12XXX 168th Street West, where a 52-year-old male driver fell asleep and struck a tree. Fortunately, no injuries were reported.
- A motorcycle was reported stolen from 17XXX Kenyon Avenue.
- A wallet was reported stolen from the behind the counter of a business on Glade Avenue.
- Officers were dispatched to Rolling Oaks Park on the report of a loud motor vehicle driving around on the baseball field. Two minibikes were in the ditch and, eventually, the two drivers were also found. They were cited accordingly.
- Two separate Theft of catalytic converters were reported at 18XXX Kenyon Avenue and 17XXX Kodiak Avenue, respectively.
- Theft from Vehicle was reported at 18XXX Kenyon Avenue. Two wallets were stolen.
- Patrol responded to a property damage Disturbance call at 17XXX Kenyon Avenue. The suspect vehicle was seen leaving the area and a Traffic Stop was conducted. The 36-year-old driver was uncooperative and displayed signs of impairment. She was ultimately jailed for 3rd Degree DWI, 4th Degree Assault, Driving After Cancellation, and 3rd Degree Damage to Property,
- Patrol assisted the IRS on a search warrant at 16XXX Dodd Lane. A 22-year-old male was arrested on three Anoka County Warrants.
- A Suspicious Activity call resulted in the arrest of a 23-year-old female at 17XXX Fortune Trail. The young woman was seen pulling on car door handles and entering a parked car. Patrol located the suspect in the area and a credit card was found on her person, which belonged to the owner of the vehicle she was seen in. She was taken into custody for Tampering with a Motor Vehicle and Theft.
- Patrol located an unoccupied vehicle, at 11XXX 210th Street West, that registered as stolen from Carver County. While investigating, a second stolen vehicle was located in the same lot. Three suspects, a 29-year-old male, a 26-year-old female, and a 35-year-old male were located. The 29-year-old male was jailed on several outstanding Warrants. The investigation is ongoing.

- Burglary was reported at 17XXX Gerdine Path. It's believed the suspect(s) opened the rear sliding glass door to obtain entry to the home. A purse and a wallet were stolen off the kitchen counter. Several days later, in connection with the case, LPD Investigators arrested a 23-year-old male for outstanding Felony Warrants and a 23-year-old female for 1st Degree Burglary.
- Patrol intervened on a Shoplifting suspect at Fleet Farm. The 35-year-old male was allowed to pay for the merchandise he was preparing to steal and then he was promptly trespassed.
- Officers responded to a Traffic Accident at Cedar Avenue and 202nd Street West. The 39-year-old female driver left the scene after damaging a power pole. She was located a short distance away, showing signs of impairment. After testing a .31 BAC, she was jailed for 3rd Degree DWI.
- Patrol located an unoccupied stolen vehicle at 17XXX Cedar Avenue.
- Theft of outdoor furniture was reported at 18XXX Lamar Lane.
- Patrol responded to a Traffic Accident at 207th Street West. A small engine moped crashed after the driver lost control. The driver sustained injury and was transported, by medics, to the hospital for care.
- Vandalism/Property Damage was reported at 6XXX Gerdine Path. An unknown suspect shot out the window of a car with a BB gun.
- A Traffic Stop, at 202nd Street West and Holyoke Avenue, resulted in the DWI arrest of a 50-year-old female driver.
- After observing another female driver almost drive into a ditch, at 210th Street West and the ramp, the 28-year-old was stopped and arrested for DWI after she failed SFST's and tested a .14 BAC.
- Patrol responded to a single vehicle Traffic Accident at 185th Street East and Judicial Road. The driver left the roadway, snapped an electrical pole in two, took out approximately 100' of fencing, and flipped the car between two pine trees. Unbelievably, and fortunately, the driver was unharmed.
- Officers responded to a severe Traffic Accident at 202nd Street West and Holyoke Avenue. One of our Officers was struck with a significant side impact, totaling the squad. A 21-year-old suspect was arrested. He sustained non-life-threatening injuries. Fortunately, our Officer sustained minor injuries only too.
