Weekly Review

Please note, if you have reviewed our Calls for Services, you'll see the Weekly Review doesn't include a comprehensive list of calls to which LPD responded. Incidents included here are based on severity, impact on public safety or other factors.

- Patrol arrested a 32-year-old female driver for DWI after she rear-ended a vehicle ahead of her at Pilot Knob and 179th Street West. She showed signs of impairment and failed SFST's, ultimately testing a .25 BAC.
- Patrol responded to a Crash, at 210th Street West and Keswick Loop, involving a dirt bike and electric longboard. One operator showed signs of a head injury and was transported to the hospital.
- Property Damage was reported to a vehicle parked at 7XXX 179th Street West.
- Patrol documented a Fraud call involving a victim being talked into opening a Bitcoin account and giving the account information to a "representative of Hulu" to end a subscription. The victim realized it was a scam, but not before \$1,250 was withdrawn from the account.
- Responding to a Driving Complaint, officers stopped a 31-year-old female driver at 17XXX Doppler Lane. She showed signs of impairment during SFST's and was charged with DWI Refusal.
- Officers arrested a 69-year-old male for Interfere with 911.
- Theft in Progress was reported after a homeowner at 16XXX Duluth Trail chased three unknown subjects out of the garage. While enroute to the call, the owner of the suspect vehicle called, reporting his vehicle had just been stolen from 16XXX Equestrian Trail. After briefly stopping, the vehicle fled just as Patrol arrived. Days later, a vehicle at the 16XXX Duluth Trail home was stolen. It's likely the suspects had stolen a key fob from the garage before being chased off.
- Vandalism was reported at 22XXX Cedar Avenue after multiple vehicles sustained flat tires in the parking lot.
- A KOPS Alert was issued for a 53-year-old male for an OFP Violation.
- A 61-year-old female was jailed on a Trespassing Violation at 20XXX Holyoke Avenue.

- Vandalism was reported to a vehicle parked at 11XXX Klamath Trail.
- Vandalism was reported at Cherry View Park after graffiti was found.

- Responding to a Driving Complaint, Patrol stopped a 28-year-old male driver at 20XXX Dodd Boulevard. He showed signs of impairment and was arrested for DWI after providing a .15 BAC.
- A Suspicion call was received on a vehicle with a driver who may have stolen mail. Patrol located the vehicle and stolen mail was recovered in addition to some Methamphetamine. The 50-year-old male was charged accordingly.
