### Weekly Review

Please note, if you have reviewed our Calls for Services, you'll see the Weekly Review doesn't include a comprehensive list of calls to which LPD responded. Incidents included here are based on severity, impact on public safety or other factors.

- A KOPS Alert was issued for Domestic Assault on a 35-year-old male.
- Patrol arrested a 38-year-old male for an OFP Violation.
- A KOPS Alert was on a 28-year-old male for a DANCO Violation.
- Multiple victims reported Mail Theft in the area of 16XXX Forbes Avenue and 16XXX Franchise Avenue.
- Officers responded to a Drunkenness call at 16XXX Gerdine Path. An intoxicated male was walking down the block, stopping in people's yards. The 41-year-old male had multiple outstanding Hennepin County Warrants, including one for 4<sup>th</sup> Degree Assault. He was arrested and transported to jail.
- Attempted Burglary was reported at 20XXX Heritage Drive. Unknown suspects attempted to pry open the front door.
- Patrol conducted a Traffic Stop at 185<sup>th</sup> Street West and Hamburg Avenue. The 39-year-old male driver showed signs of impairment. Following SFST failures, he was arrested for 4<sup>th</sup> Degree DWI and ultimately tested a .09 BAC.
- A 45-year-old male was arrested, and jailed, on an outstanding Scott County Warrant.
- Theft from Vehicle was reported at 17XXX Kenrick Avenue. The victim's window was smashed and over \$600 in cash was stolen.
- Fraud was reported by a victim who believed a personal computer had been hacked and called the number associated with the pop-up window. After providing the unknown suspect with remote access to the computer, the suspect accessed banking accounts and moved funds from one account to the other. The suspect then asked for several hundred dollars of gift cards and the victim provided the suspect with pictures.
- Theft from Vehicle was reported at Ritter Farm Park. A bag was stolen from an unlocked vehicle.
- Vehicle Theft was reported at 21XXX Keswick Loop. A truck was stolen from the parking lot and located a few hours later by Steele County Deputies. They took the 41-year-old suspect into custody.
- A 4<sup>th</sup> Degree DWI arrest was made following a Traffic Stop at Cedar Avenue and 202<sup>nd</sup> Street. The 28-year-old female driver failed SFST's and tested a .09 BAC.
