Weekly Review

Please note, if you have reviewed our Calls for Services, you'll see the Weekly Review doesn't include a comprehensive list of calls to which LPD responded. Incidents included here are based on severity, impact on public safety or other factors.

- A hit-and-run Traffic Accident was reported at 16XXX Kenrick Avenue.
- Another hit-and-run Traffic Accident was reported at 8XXX 208th Street West.
- A 40-year-old male was arrested and jailed on numerous charges including Domestic Assault, Terroristic Threats, and Possession of Stolen Property.
- Patrol took a Fraud report from a victim who was trying to contact a security software company and ended up on the phone with scammers. The unknown suspects gained remote access to the victim's computer and accessed financial records. Over \$6k was withdrawn from multiple accounts.
- Patrol took a Fraud report from a victim whose social media account had been compromised. The victim attempted to call the Facebook helpline but somehow, unknowingly, got a fraudulent number and was instructed to install applications on a personal phone and then provided electronic links. Upon clicking on the links, a fraudulent Venmo transaction occurred totaling over \$2k.
- A 30-year-old female was arrested on outstanding Warrants.
- Officers responded to a multi-vehicle crash at 167th Street West and Cedar Avenue. It was reported the cause of the crash was a driver coming to an abrupt stop to avoid geese in the roadway, resulting in a chain reaction. One party was transported to the hospital with a head injury.
- Officers responded to 20XXX Icenic Trail on a Fraud in Progress. A 33-year-old male was trying to cash a check that wasn't made payable to him. The check was later determined to have been stolen and the suspect was arrested and jailed.
- Theft from Vehicle was reported at 18XXX Glenbridge Road.
- Patrol responded to a Traffic Accident at Dodd and Fairgreen. The at-fault driver ran the stop sign on Fairgreen and was struck by the victim vehicle. Both drivers were transported to the hospital with non-life-threatening injuries.

- A 26-year-old male was arrested on several outstanding Warrants.
- Mail Theft was reported at 8XXX Lower 208th Street after the victim was notified a package had been delivered but it was never received.
- Patrol arrested a 44-year-old male for 2nd Degree Assault.
- Officers responded to an Assault call involving a 19-year-old male. The suspect fled before Officer arrival. Later, Officers responded to the scene on a report the suspect had returned. Again, he fled but was ultimately arrested by our partners in Rice County.
- Responding to a Traffic Accident, at 17XXX Glacier Way, officers discovered one 19-year-old female driver intoxicated. She failed SFST's and was jailed for 3rd Degree DWI, ultimately testing a .22 BAC.
