- Fraud Activity reported after the reporting party fell victim to a Craigslist scam. He listed a \$1,000.00 item for sale. The suspect expressed interest in the item and provided a check for over triple the cost of the item. The suspect requested the remainder be overnighted back. Of course, the check was bad and now the victim is out the funds.
- A 39-year old male was arrested for Domestic Assault.
