- Patrol responded to no less than seven (7) Mental Health Crisis calls.
- Traffic Stop at I-35 and 195 Street West resulted in the arrest of a 34-year old male for multiple violations including GM False Info, No MN DL and Speed.
- A bicycle was reported stolen from 18XXX Dodd Boulevard.
- During the storm, patrol responded to two (2) homes struck by lightning; one on Icon Court and another on Heidelberg Way. Fortunately, no one was injured. They also aided several vehicles under water. Two were submerged like submarines on Cedar Avenue and 185th Street West. Another was stalled at Gerdine Path and 167th Court West.
- Vandalism/Property Damage to a mailbox reported at 8XXX 220th Street West.
- Theft of a trailer reported from 21XXX Cedar Avenue. The trailer's value, along with its commercial contents, totals a loss of over \$70,000.00
- Damage to Property reported at 21XXX Illavista Way. A screen door was slashed and a window was damaged.
- Burglaries were reported from 20XXX Kenrick Avenue and 20XXX Keokuk Avenue.
- Theft from Vehicle reported at 16XXX Dodd Lane. Unknown suspect(s) entered the unlocked car and made away with property.
- Theft from Vehicle reported at 20XXX Holyoke Avenue.
- A 39-year old male was arrested for Felony Strangulation and Careless Driving after he fled from a domestic altercation.
- LPD and LFD assisted State Patrol as they investigated a 4-car crash on I-35 and CR-50.
- A 35-year old male was arrested, at Dodd Boulevard and Hayes Avenue, for 2nd Degree DWI after he was observed crashing into a yield sign and failing to stop. He provided a .22 DMT.
