Weekly Review

- Patrol responded to no less than four (4) Mental Health Crisis calls.
- DWI arrest made on Kenyon Avenue after a 33-year old female was found slumped over in the driver's seat, sleeping. She failed sobriety testing and was arrested for 4th Degree DWI after testing a .14 BAC.
- Theft of mail reported from 9XXX 202nd Street West.
- Theft of a bicycle reported from 18XXX Dodd Boulevard.
- Fraud Activity reported after the victim fell for the "Green Dot" Card Scam. What is the "Green Dot" Card Scam? It's fraudsters who impersonate companies or government agencies and ask for money they claim you owe in the form of a MoneyPak number.
- Patrol responded to an Arson case on Glencoe Circle. A van appeared to be set on fire. The vehicle was parked near the house and caused significant damage to the dwelling and another vehicle parked nearby.
- Theft of numerous construction tools reported at 205th Street West and Greenwood Avenue. Locked trailers were breached at a new housing construction site.
- A vehicle was stolen from an open garage at 16XXX Engelman Way. A few days later patrol responded to a Suspicious Vehicle and found it to be the stolen. It was recovered and processed.
- Forced Burglary was discovered at two model homes, one on 16XXX Dutch Barn Drive and another on 16XXX Draft Horse Boulevard. Cabinets and countertops were stolen.
- A bicycle was stolen from an open garage at 16XXX Finch Avenue.
- Burglary was reported at 20XXX Holyoke Avenue. The suspect(s) entered through an unlocked door and stole cash from the register.
- Theft of a van was reported from Anthony Drive. Shortly after processing the vehicle as stolen, Wisconsin State Patrol stopped it and took a 22-year old male suspect into custody.

- Patrol assisted State Patrol in stopping a drunk driver, on I-35 NB and 210th Street West, who was driving the wrong way on the interstate.
- Burglary reported from 6XXX 175th Street West. A handgun was stolen out of a vehicle parked in an open garage.
- A wallet was stolen from a vehicle parked in an open garage at 16XXX Endeavor Court. A mountain bike was also taken from the garage.
- A vehicle was reported stolen from 17XXX Glasgow Avenue.
- Theft from Vehicle reported at 20XXX Jupiter Way.
- Stolen car reported at 17XXX Gillette Way. The keys were left in the unlocked vehicle.
- A trailer was broken at Cedar Avenue and 222nd Street West. Equipment, valued at \$3,000.00, was taken.
- Patrol responded to a loud noise and a vehicle fleeing the area of 16XXX Hudson Avenue. A large firework had been thrown into the garage, damaging a vehicle, the floor and possibly the ceiling. Following investigation, a 20-year old male was arrested for the incident.
- Responding to a Driving Complaint, Patrol arrested a 19-year old male, at I-35 SB and 195th Street, for DWI Test Refusal after he failed sobriety testing.
- Theft of copper coiling reported from an industrial AC unit being stored at 21XXX Humboldt Court.
