Weekly Review

- Patrol responded to a Domestic call and a 33-year old male was charged with 5<sup>th</sup> Degree Domestic Assault.
- Officers responded to no less than ten (10) Mental Health Crisis calls.
- Patrol responded to a Terroristic Threats call at 21XXX Kenrick Avenue. A 36-year old male was charged with Felony Threats, Felony Damage to Property, Felony Assault, and Misdemeanor Theft.
- Theft of tools, from an unsecured truck bed, was reported from 20XXX Keokuk Avenue.
- A pull-behind trailer was stolen from 4XXX Romeo Drive.
- Vandalism/Property Damage was reported at 16XXX Interlachen Boulevard.
- Theft from Vehicle was reported at 17XXX Jalisco Lane. An iPad and Apple watch were stolen.
- Vandalism/Property Damage was reported at 8XXX 213<sup>th</sup> Street West. Two mailboxes were found damaged.
- Officers responded to a Disturbance/Disorderly Conduct call at 16XXX Joplin Way and trespassed a 25-year old male.
- What came in as a possible Robbery ended up being a Drug Activity call. A 41-year old male and a 31-year old female were arguing, at Pilot Knob Road and 173<sup>rd</sup> Street West, over some meth.
