Weekly Review

- Traffic Stop, at 215th Street West and Dodd Boulevard, resulted in the DWI arrest of a 24-year old male. He provided a .16 BAC and is charged with 3rd Degree DWI and Reckless Driving.
- Patrol responded to no less than nine (9) Mental Health Crisis calls.
- A 40-year old male was cited for an OFP Violation.
- Fraud Activity reported from a victim who was convinced he had won a \$500,000 sweepstakes. The unknown scammer convinced him to send \$18,300, in certified checks, to collect the winnings. No winnings have been collected.
- Responding to a Driving Complaint, a 28-year old male was arrested, at 173rd Street West and Halifax Path, for 4th Degree DWI. By his own admission, he was under the influence of heroin and marijuana.
- A 33-year old male was cited for Theft from Walmart.
- Theft was reported from a worksite at 21XXX Jacquard Avenue.
- Vandalism/Property Damage occurred to a boat at 16XXX Draft Horse Court. Unknown persons threw a large number of fireworks into a boat, causing extensive damage to the interior.
- Vandalism/Property Damage was reported to the building and picnic tables at Valley Lake Park.
- Mail Theft was reported from 9XXX 178th Street West.
- Patrol responded to a 4-vehicle Property Damage crash at 168th Street West and Langley Avenue. The resident heard a crash outside the home. Upon investigation, he observed an SUV had struck three of his vehicles, parked on the street. All cars sustained extensive damage. Two male occupants had exited the suspect vehicle. One, a 39-year old, sat on the driveway. The other, a 38-year old, fled on foot. A nearby resident called to report a suspicious male behind his home. Officers took him into custody and brought him back to the scene. Both males appeared extremely impaired and neither would admit to driving. Fortunately, once in the squad car, a heated discussion occurred between the two friends and the 39-year old is on camera confessing.
- Three's a Crowd: Patrol mediated a Verbal Domestic between a young man and the two females he was courting. After he had the nerve to invite both back to his apartment, the women were infuriated and wanted to fight each other!
