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Weekly Review

- Patrol responded to at least seven (7) Mental Health Crisis calls.
- Vandalism/Property Damage reported at 21XXX Kenrick Avenue. Several vehicles suffered smashed windows and/or slashed tires.
- A bicycle was reported Stolen from 17XXX Jubilee Way.
- Theft of tools was reported from a trailer at 19XXX Iteri Avenue.
- Theft of a bicycle reported from 16XXX Joplin Avenue.
- Vandalism of signage reported in the area of Icon Trail and Idalia Path.
- Patrol responded to a 5-car Traffic Accident, at Pilot Knob Road and 160th Street West. Two vehicles and a trailer were inoperable and towed. Fortunately, there were no reported injuries.
- Traffic Stop, at 162nd Street West and Ipava, resulted in the arrest of a 57-year old male for 3rd Degree DWI. He tested a .18 BAC.

- A Lyft driver called police to report a medical incident at 16XXX Jatos Circle when the customer in his backseat would not wake up. A quick investigation with the victim's family revealed that the adult female has a history of drug use and the adult female was transported to the hospital for further evaluation.
